#### Annual Auction

#### World Down Syndrome Day



World Down Syndrome Day is celebrated each year on the 21st of March. The day signifies the uniqueness of the triplication of the 21st chromosome which causes Down syndrome. The DSCBA celebrates the day with our members with a sock hop dance party.

#### T21 Fun Run



A Fun Run for everyone! This annual event takes place simultaneously at 2 locations; the Lafayette Reservoir Loop and Spring Lake Loop in Santa Rosa. The distance is about 3 miles on a paved path at both locations.

Our THRIVE program is conducted by age groups with a focus on developing strong core strength, gross and fine motor as well as social and friendship-building skills.

#### Communication Readiness Program (CRP)



A 6-week summer program for early elementary children aged 6 - 7 with complex communication needs. The program incorporates reading, writing, art, music, obstacle courses, speech and socialization with communication and school readiness skills at the core of the program.



Music Therapy

Music therapy merges the joy of music with therapeutic goals, using interventions like singing, instrument playing, improvisation, and musical games to support speech, physical, cognitive, academic, and behavioral development.

#### Family Support - Connections



Our Connection Groups offer opportunities for families to meet with those who have similar interests and are seeking peer support.

#### Holiday Celebrations



The DSCBA members and their families are invited to attend holiday celebrations at multiple locations in the Bay Area. These free events include a visit with Santa and his elves, visit to a Tree Farm and a Holiday luncheon. Over 500 attendees enjoy these festive celebrations!

#### iCan Shine Bike Camp



Riders learn to balance, pedal, steer and ride on their own. Sessions run for 75 minutes each day for 5 days.

The program is an adapted approach to each individual rider based on the accommodation's they may need to benefit the most from the program.
