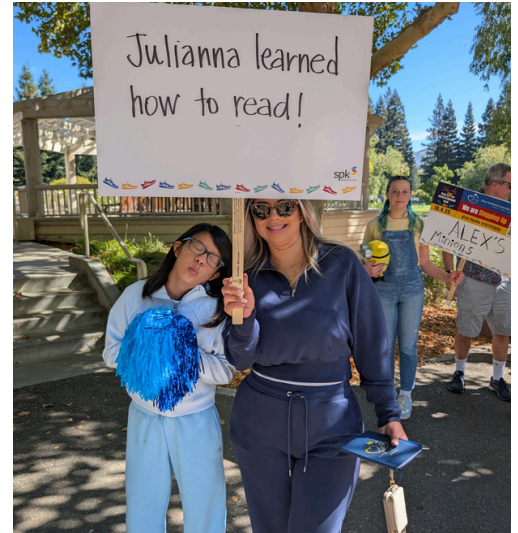
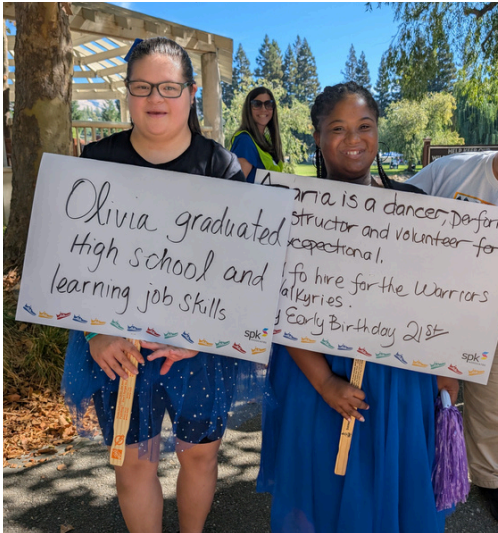

World Down Syndrome Day

World Down Syndrome Day is celebrated each year on the 21st of March. The day signifies the uniqueness of the triplication of the 21st chromosome which causes Down syndrome. The DSCBA celebrates the day with our members with a dance party.



Annual Auction

The Annual Auction is an elegant evening where our community comes together to dine, celebrate, and give back. This signature event welcomes more than 250 guests for a memorable night of generosity, with proceeds supporting the vital programs and services that sustain our mission year-round.



Dance-A-Thon

Dance-A-Thon is an inclusive, high-energy event that brings our community together through dance, movement, music, and joy while supporting the DSCBA. Participants can fundraise by collecting pledges as they dance, helping strengthen our programs and services. All ages and abilities are welcome as we raise awareness and celebrate together!



T21 Fun Run

This annual event takes place at two scenic Bay Area locations: the Lafayette Reservoir and Spring Lake in Santa Rosa. Each course offers approximately three miles of paved paths, giving participants the option to walk or run at their own pace.

Down syndrome is caused by an extra copy of the 21st chromosome—referred to as Trisomy 21 (T21).



Step Up for Down Syndrome Walk

The Bay Area Step Up for Down Syndrome Walk & Family Picnic brings our community together for a day filled with fun activities, inspirational walkers, meaningful fundraising, and joyful celebration. One of the most beloved moments of the event is the finish line, where we cheer loudly and proudly for our members as they cross, honoring their achievements and spirit.



Holiday Celebrations

DSCBA members and their families attend free holiday celebrations at 3 Bay Area locations. These festive events include visits with Santa and his elves, a magical Tree Farm experience, sing-alongs, treats, and fun photo opportunities. More than 500 attendees enjoy these joyful celebrations each year!



Music Therapy

Music therapy merges the joy of music with therapeutic goals, using interventions like singing, instrument playing, improvisation, and musical games to support speech, physical, cognitive, academic, and behavioral development.



iCan Shine Bike Camp

Riders learn to ride, pedal, and steer a bike independently. Sessions run for 75 minutes each day for five days. The program provides an adaptive approach for each individual rider based on the accommodations they need.



Communication Readiness Program (CRP)

A 6-week summer program for early elementary children aged 4-8 with complex communication needs. The program incorporates reading, writing, art, music, obstacle courses, speech and socialization with communication and school readiness skills at the core of the program.



THRIVE Program

THRIVE is a unique program for individuals with Down syndrome. It is conducted by age groups with a focus on developing strong core strength, gross and fine motor as well as social and friendship-building skills. These sessions embody a unique combination of strengthening cognitive skills and social/behavioral interactions, all while fostering lifelong friendships and having fun.



Family Support - Connections

Our Connection Groups offer opportunities for families to meet with those who have similar interests and are seeking peer support. Our programs are a safe and confidential place where we talk about issues we have in common with others.
